PURPOSE

To honor Florida's top senior male and female school scholar/athletes.

REQUIREMENTS

1. 12th grade.
2. 3.0 unweighted GPA.
3. Minimum of 1210 on SAT or 27 on ACT.
4. **A COPY OF OFFICIAL HIGH SCHOOL TRANSCRIPT THROUGH FIRST SEMESTER OF SENIOR YEAR.**
5. Participated in varsity level athletics a minimum of two (2) years, one year in 12th grade.
6. Information must be submitted on nomination and resume forms (see back of this sheet.) Please include a picture (wallet size) with your nomination form. **Nomination forms must be signed by the Principal and Athletic Director.**

NOMINATION

1. Every Florida high school may nominate one male and one female.
2. School Athletic Directors must submit applications of FIAAA District Director by April 15th.

SELECTION PROCESS

1. A maximum of three males and three females (one per classification) will be selected by each FIAAA Director.
2. One (1) male and one (1) female winner will be selected from each of three designated categories (based on the FHSAA football classifications) plus two additional at-large winners from all applicants as determined by the selection committee. There will be a total of three (3) males and three (3) females plus two (2) additional at-large winners, for a total of eight (8) scholarship winners.
3. Winners will be selected by the FIAAA Higher Education Committee.

RECOGNITION

1. \$500.00 cash award and plaque presented to winners.
2. Winners will be announced at the FIAAA State Conference and on the FIAAA Website at FIAAA.org.
